## WAGE THEFT ORDINANCE AFFIDAVIT

Effective January 1, 2023, every business operator required to obtain a business license under Chapter 18 of the Mountain View City Code shall be required to submit a sworn affidavit at the same time the application for a business license or business license renewal is submitted to the tax administrator.

Business operators with no employees are exempt and are not required to submit a sworn affidavit.
